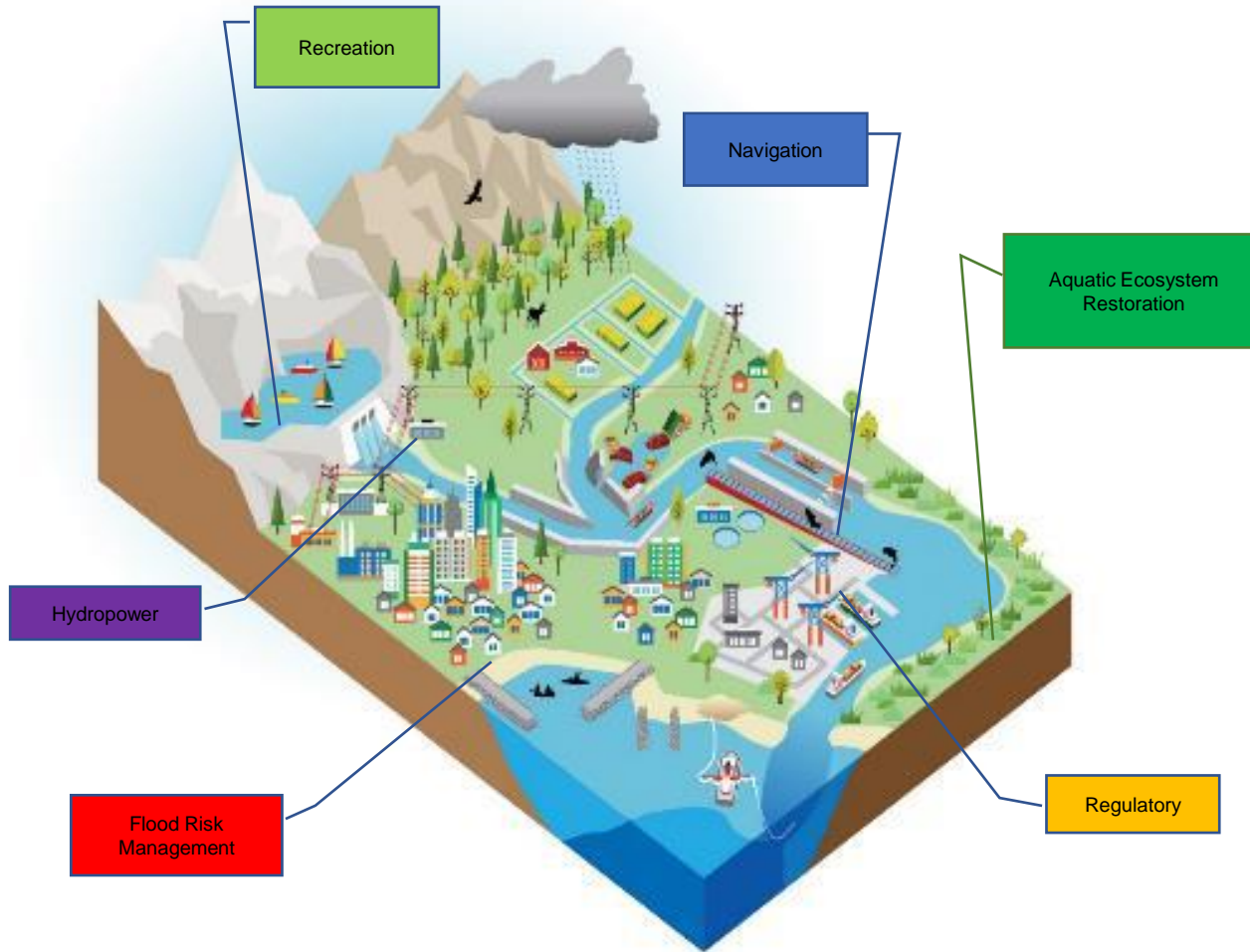

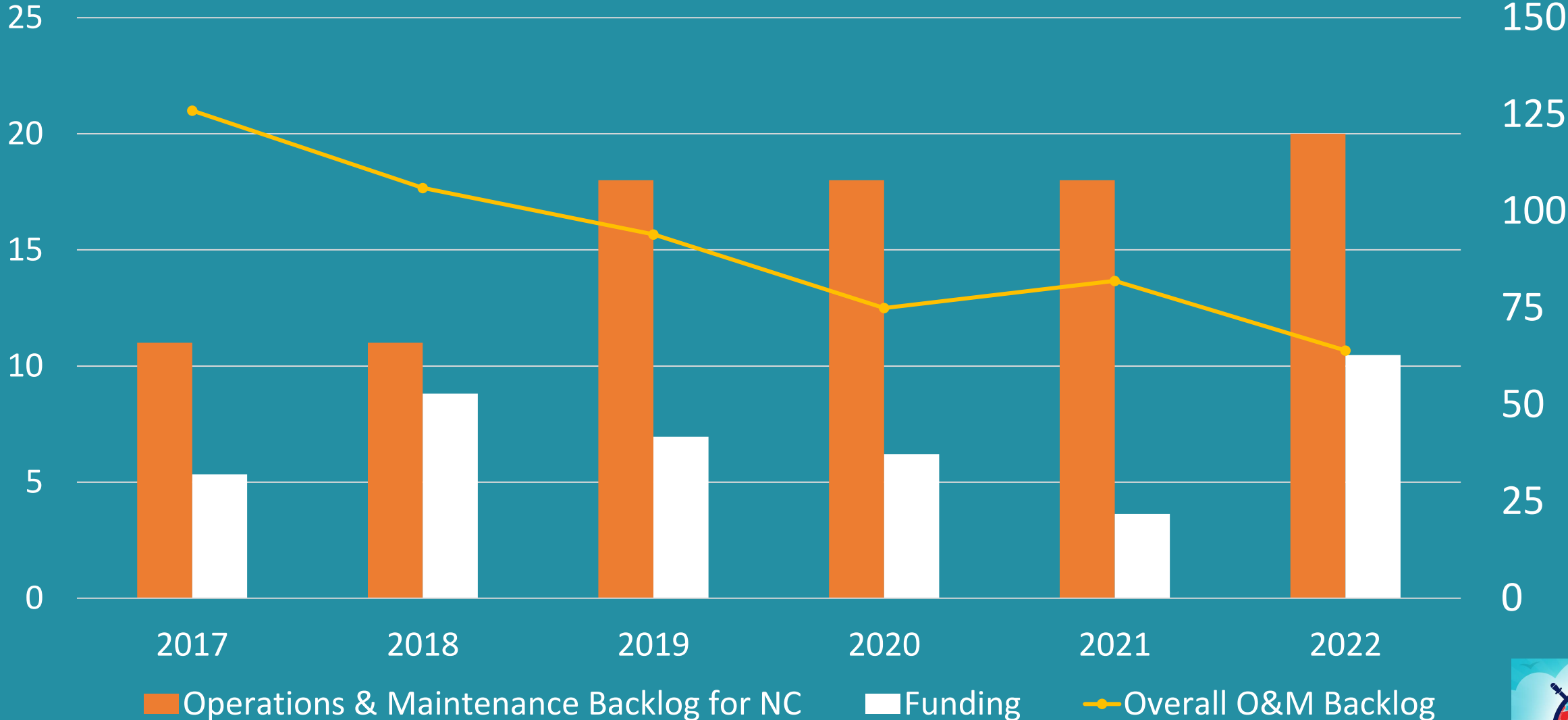


AIWW/IWW Needs Assessment 2022 Update

- WRRDA 2014 requires Corps of Engineers to quantify annual maintenance dredging needs of AIWW/IWW and provide report to Congress.
- 2022 estimate is \$63.5M to return to authorized width and depth (2016 estimate was \$126M). NC is \$20M.
- Annual Maintenance estimate is \$49.5M (2016 estimate was \$50.2M). NC is \$15M.
- Maintenance dredging projects conducted or planned in every state from VA to FL in 2022 and 2023.

Moving forward!

- Continue engagement on execution of FY22 Appropriations for U.S. Army Corps of Engineers.
- Support FY23 district amounts while pursuing Additional Dredging Needs funding pots. Monitor Continuing Resolution process.
- Partner with agencies and stakeholders in support of beneficial use of dredge materials.
- Continue outreach to elected officials through periodic communications and Washington, D.C. Advocacy trip in March.
- Provide opportunities for engagement between stakeholders and decision-makers through collaboration with partner organizations. Next opportunity is Annual Meeting in Norfolk, VA on 11/15-11/17.
